## Buco Del Prete Cru Sangiovese

*Buco del Prete by Ronchi di Castelluccio is a characterful and expressive wine that reflects the identity of the estate's hillside vineyards. It reveals notes of ripe fruit, wild herbs, and subtle earthy nuances. On the palate, it is structured and balanced, with a natural elegance and a long, persistent finish.*

### Flavor profile

The label design is inspired by historic Ronchi labels from the early 1980s and features the vineyard's surrounding wood. The wine has a rich fruit flavor and is representative of Sangiovese di Modigliana.
