Buco del Prete by Ronchi di Castelluccio is a characterful and expressive wine that reflects the identity of the estate's hillside vineyards. It reveals notes of ripe fruit, wild herbs, and subtle earthy nuances. On the palate, it is structured and balanced, with a natural elegance and a long, persistent finish.

Flavor profile

This Sangiovese wine offers rich fruit flavors with bright acidity, smooth tannins, and a vibrant representation of the Modigliana terroir.

Food pairing

Pair with red meats and tomato-based sauces.

Tasting notes

Buco del Prete is a Sangiovese wine made with hand-harvested grapes. The wine has a rich fruit flavor and is representative of Sangiovese di Modigliana. The label design is inspired by historic Ronchi labels from the early 1980s and features the vineyard's surrounding wood.

Winemaking

Fermentation in steel, 25 days of macerations on the skins

Aging

Aging for 10 months in large 3,000-liter French oak barrels with very minimal toasting, at least 6 months in bottle
