



Mazzolada Cabernet

Mazzolada Cabernet by Mazzolada is a structured and expressive red wine that highlights the varietal character of Cabernet in a refined, approachable style. It opens with notes of dark berries, blackcurrant, and subtle vegetal hints, enriched by light spices. On the palate, it is smooth and well-balanced, with soft tannins and a persistent, elegant finish.

Flavor profile

The wine has a deep ruby color with a ripe red fruit aroma. It has a full body and a smooth texture, with chocolatey tannins and hints of wild fruit.

Food pairing

De Stefani Cabernet pairs well with tagliatelle and Bolognese sauce, as well as red meat, braised beef, and roast meat.

Tasting notes

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Winemaking

Destemming and crushing of the grapes, maceration and fermentation at controlled temp. With frequent pumping over. Ends its fermentation in stainless steel vats.

Aging

The wine matures for 8-12 months on its noble lees in oak barrique and barrels.
