# I Stefanini

## Il Selese

*Il Selese 2021 by I Stefanini is a vibrant and terroir-driven white wine that captures the volcanic soul of the Soave hills. Bright and expressive, it reveals notes of white flowers, citrus zest, and crisp orchard fruit, intertwined with a subtle mineral edge. On the palate, it is fresh and precise, with lively acidity and a clean, elegant finish that enhances its finesse and drinkability.*

**Flavor profile**

Straw yellow color with greenish reflections. On the nose, ripe stone fruit aromas Sweetness: Pleasant hint due to the aroma profile rather than to residual sugar. Finish: Refreshing finish and minerality persists. On the palate, bright acidity and minerality.

**Food pairing**

Perfect with light appetizers or fish and vegetables.

**Tasting notes**

Straw yellow color with greenish reflections. Delicate aromas of ripe peach, apricot, and flowers. The palate is dry and medium-bodied with a long mineral finish. On the palate, Bright acidity and minerality.

**Winemaking**

Soft pressing of de-stemmed grapes, fermentation at controlled temperature totally in steel, long aging on the yeasts until bottling.
