Negroamaro

Negroamaro by Bonsegna is a rich and expressive red wine, showcasing the character of this native grape. It opens with notes of dark berries, plum, and subtle spice, with light herbal undertones. The palate is smooth and well-structured, with soft tannins and a persistent finish.

Flavor profile

The wine has a light garnet color and an intense aroma of ripe black fruits like plum and cherry, with hints of balsamic. On the nose, ripe fruit, like plum and black cherry, with balsamic undertones. On the palate, soft acidity balanced by sweet fruitiness.

Food pairing

This wine complements roasted meats and tomato-based pasta dishes. While it can be enjoyed immediately, allowing it to breathe for half an hour after opening will enhance its overall balance.

Tasting notes

The wine has a light garnet color and an intense aroma of ripe black fruits like plum and cherry, with hints of balsamic. The texture of the palate is rich and smooth, with a pleasant spiciness in the finish accompanied by some sweetness notes. On the palate, Soft acidity balanced by sweet fruitiness.
