## Pinot Nero

*Pinot Nero 2018 by Frascole is a delicate and intriguing interpretation of this noble grape in the Tuscan Apennines. Fragrant and expressive, it unveils aromas of wild berries, rose petals, and light earthy undertones. On the palate, it is smooth and refined, with silky tannins and a graceful structure that highlights finesse over power.*

### Flavor profile

Aroma of ripe red fruits, such as cherry and strawberries. It has soft chocolatey tannins and is moderately dry.

### Food pairing

A versatile wine pair with beef bourgogne or grilled red meats. Also great on its own.

### Tasting notes

Aroma of ripe red fruits, such as cherry and strawberries. It has soft chocolatey tannins and is moderately dry. An old world style Pinot Noir.

### Winemaking

Aged in 225 litre barriques for 12 months. Assembled in a cement tank and bottled after about 5 months. It is refined in the bottle for a year.
