# Bonsegna Primitivo

*Primitivo by Bonsegna is a warm and enveloping red wine, defined by ripe fruit intensity and softness. It reveals notes of blackberry, cherry jam, and sweet spice. On the palate, it is full-bodied and smooth, with velvety tannins and a long, satisfying finish.*

**Flavor profile**

Vibrant ruby color. Intense aromas of ripe red fruits such as blackberry and cherry, with spicy notes of pepper. The palate is well balanced among texture, fruit, and soft tannins.

**Food pairing**

Recommended with roasted meats or any tomato-based pasta dish. Serve at 63°F in a medium-wide glass. Can be enjoyed straight away, but half an hour from opening improves the overall balance.

**Tasting notes**

Vinified with 100% Primitivo grapes, this ruby red wine is well structured and dry, with an intense fruity aroma. Completed by harmonious tertiary notes with ripe red fruit.

**Winemaking**

Maceration of selected grapes at a controlled temperature for 8-10 days.

**Aging**

Aging in steel for 12 months.

1-5 years
